Individualized Program Plan (IPP) The purpose of the IPP is to establish individualized programming, it is essential to identify a child's strengths and specific learning needs. #### » PUF Information

During the month of October PUF children will receive an IPP with goals for the year. Parents will have a meeting with the BCESA team to review the IPP. Regular therapy visits will also begin this month. Severe children will see the therapists weekly.

#### MM Information

This month, MM children will continue to be observed by therapists and IPPs will be written and sent to parents in November. Regular therapist visits will begin next month. MM children will have individual and group sessions 1-2 times a month.
